

# Certified in Homeland Security, CHS Level V Prep-Course

## Abstract:

The CHS-V certification is designed to ensure that certificants have a strong working knowledge of the threat posed by Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, and Explosive (CBRNE) incidents and the resources that those working on Homeland Security have to combat the threat of CBRNE incidents. Potential certificants will be required to show knowledge of the threats presented by a range of chemical, biological, radiological, and explosive and nuclear weapons. This Knowledge includes:

- How to recognize and appropriately react to a range of CBTNE threats.
- How to identify various chemical agents, including their indicators and symptoms.
- How to identify various biological threats, including their symptoms and characteristics
- An understanding of nuclear threats, including the difference between nuclear and radiological threats
- How to utilize Mass decontamination basics
- How to utilize HazMat/WMD basics

Certificants will also have to show knowledge of the National Prevention Framework, and the Department of Homeland Security's role in preventing and mitigating the consequences of these types of events.
